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10 Your tee shot needs to reach the bottom of the hill to avoid a downhill lie to an elevated green. If the pin is left, the smart play is just right of center.



11 With trouble nestled up against the back of this green, avoid being long on this straight forward par 3.



12 Play your tee shot to the left side of the fairway around the 150 marker. This will leave a good approach to this difficult back to front sloping green that is made for 3 putts.



13 A relatively straight forward par 3, the key is judging distance coming off the hill hitting your tee shot between the rock formations.



14 For most hitters, just to the right of the tree on the left side of the fairway is a solid target line. One of the shallowest greens on the course so judging distance on the approach is important.



15 Carrying the rock formation to cut the corner is not a viable option. There is nothing but scrub oak on the other side. Play to the corner and hit a short iron into the green which slopes from back to front.



16 This is the longest hole on the course. The correct line is down the left side of the fairway. As you approach the green, this hole has a great view of Denver in the background.



17 Out of all of the par 3's this proves to be the most difficult. This is a deep green and is easily a full club distance from front to back.



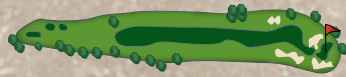
18 The finishing hole is a short par 5, and long hitters need to leave their driver in the bag as there is a lake at the top of the hill. The green breaks significantly from right to left.





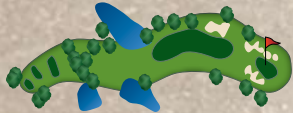
1 One of the longest par 4's on the course. Aim left of the fairway bunker, as the fairway slopes right to left.

2 The green on this three shot par five has a shelf in the center, causing approaches to break severely from left to right, so approach placement is critical based on pin location.



3 Club selection is the key here as there is a lot more trouble long than short. Notice the great view of downtown Denver just left of the red rock formation.

4 Tee shots should be played down the right edge of the fairway as all shots kick to the left. Longer is better on your second shot to avoid the water hazard in front of the green.



5 It's best to place your tee shot in the center of the fairway between 75 and 100 yards out. Expect your putt to break much more than it appears on this severely sloped green.

6 Although it's not the longest par 4; it plays long because it's mostly uphill. Two well played shots will give you a great birdie opportunity, as this is one of the flatter greens on the course.



7 Keep your driver in the bag on this one. The green moves swiftly from left to right so your approach will mean the difference between par or double.

8 Long hitters can make it to the top of the hill on this par 4 which is the best position. The challenge is merely making sure you take enough club to reach the green on this uphill approach.



9 Originally designed as the finishing hole. Club selection is the key from this elevated tee box. What you see is what you get here.
