90 Degree Rule

Members please keep in mind that the 90 degree rule is only in place to enhance your course conditions. The 90 degree rule and the pin placement for the day will be posted on the post just before you enter the course and in the pro shop on the days it applies. The 90 degree rule at Lee's Hill is this: Drive your cart on the path till you are 90 degrees even with your ball, turn 90 degrees and go directly to your ball. After playing your shot, exit fairway at 90 degrees back to the cart path. Proceed in the same fashion to your next shot. If you advance the ball only a few yards you may drive in the fairway to your ball.
