11TH ANNUAL WASHINGTON STATE WOMEN'S BEST-BALL CHAMPIONSHIP

FOUR-BALL STROKE PLAY

**Yakima Country Club • Yakima, Washington
May 24 - 25, 2010**

**Field Limit: 60 Teams • Entry Fee: \$350 (Per Team)
Entry Deadline: May 3, 2010 at 4:30 p.m.**

ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to two-player teams of amateur golfers who are female and who: a) are members in good standing of a WSGA member club; b) each have a USGA Handicap Index not exceeding 33.2 at the time of entry; and c) partners' Course Handicaps must be within 8 strokes of one another or an adjustment will be made to the player with the higher Course Handicap to meet this criteria.

ENTRIES

Teams may apply electronically via the WSGA website, www.thewsga.org (credit card will be charged at the time of entry). Teams may also apply on a WSGA entry form obtainable from the WSGA office or downloadable from the WSGA website. **Team members must register together.** An entry fee of \$350 shall be paid by each team (including exempt team).

Online registration or signed and completed paper entries, along with the appropriate fee, must be received by the WSGA by 4:30 p.m., on May 3, 2010. Walk-in entries will be accepted anytime, but must be received by 4:30 p.m. on May 3, 2010. Entries by telephone, e-mail, fax or incomplete entries will not be accepted. Entries should be mailed early to allow ample time for delay or error. The WSGA is not responsible for lost or misdirected mail. Refunds due to cancellation on or before May 17, 2010 are subject to a \$25 service charge per player. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED AFTER MAY 17, 2010.**

Late entries will be accepted and placed on an alternate's list to fill spots if they become available up until the time that the WSGA Staff establishes final pairings. Late entries will not be accepted unless they are accompanied by the correct entry fee, plus an additional administrative fee of \$25. Contestants must contact the WSGA in order to submit a late entry.

CONDITIONS

The WSGA Women's Best-Ball Championship Committee reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The Committee reserves the right to reject the entry of any applicant, at any time, for any reason. Any decision by the Committee, in any matter, shall be final.

"SPIKELESS" SHOE POLICY

It is a condition of this competition that contestants will not be permitted to wear shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course) are prohibited during Championship play (to include practice rounds). Contestants in non-compliance with the "spikeless" policy will not be permitted to start. Players must arrive on the tee ready to play. Extra time will not be afforded for non-metal spike installation or the changing of shoes. Failure to comply with the "spikeless" shoe policy will result in immediate disqualification.

CARTS/CADDIES

The use of automotive carts during the Championship is permitted. Cart fees will be \$35 per cart, per day and must be remitted to the WSGA office along with the entry fee. Since this is a team competition, only one cart per team is permitted. Contestants who wish to reserve a cart must indicate so on the entry form. Contestants who reserve a cart and do not cancel at least seven days prior to the Championship will be held responsible for the associated cart fees even if she subsequently decides to walk or provide her own caddie. Host club caddies may be available, contact the golf shop regarding availability. A player may furnish her own caddie.

DRESS CODE

The WSGA expects all contestants and their caddies to wear suitable attire on the host club property throughout the duration of the championship, including practice rounds. Suitable attire does not include cutoffs, short shorts, tank tops, halters, jeans or denim of any kind or color; tee shirts, bare midriff, spandex, sweat pants or unkempt clothing of any kind. Contestants must wear tailored blouses or golf shirts (if a shirt is sleeveless, it must have a collar). Contestants must wear slacks, golf skirts or shorts. Skirts and shorts must not be shorter than 5 inches above the middle of the knee. Hats and visors must not be worn in the clubhouse. Shoes and socks must be worn at all times. Sandals of any kind are not allowed on the golf course at any time (including practice areas), even sandals with soft spikes. If additional measures are required by the host club, they will be communicated to all contestants prior to the championship and must be adhered to. Gallery must adhere to the host club dress code policy. Failure to adhere to the dress code may result in disqualification and removal from the course.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Unacceptable conduct or behavior on the golf course or anywhere on club property will not be tolerated and are grounds for immediate disqualification, at any time, from any WSGA Championship. **The WSGA definition of unacceptable conduct or behavior will be provided at the Championship.**

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

As a condition of this competition, the use of cellular phones, noise making pagers, radios, walkmans, iPods and any other similar electronic, noise making device will be prohibited during Championship play. Clarifications and special requests regarding this condition should be directed to the WSGA Rules Committee in advance. **NOTE:** Distance measuring devices will be allowed for this championship. Additional information regarding the local rule of using distance measuring devices will be published in the Player Confirmation and Notice to Competitors.

CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE

Full field will play 18 holes of Four-Ball Stroke Play (more commonly referred to as Best-Ball) each day. Gross and net competition. Ties for the overall Championship will be decided by a sudden-death playoff, in four-ball format, immediately following the conclusion of play.

9:00 A.M. Shotgun Start

WITHDRAWAL POLICY

Entrants that withdraw after the entry deadline must notify the WSGA (206-526-8605) promptly in order to insure an alternate fair opportunity to play.

A "withdrawal form" will be available at registration and the scoring table and must be completed by any competitor withdrawing during the course of the championship. Entrants who unofficially withdraw (by not filling out a form or without a sufficient reason) will not be granted entry into any future WSGA event for a minimum of two years.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY/PRACTICE ROUND

Entrants that have met eligibility requirements will receive a confirmation of entry that will include specific practice round information and any other necessary details of the championship.

LODGING

The WSGA recommends that contestants make their lodging arrangements at the earliest possible date. The WSGA has made arrangements for reserved rooms at the following hotels. When making reservations, contestants must identify themselves as WSGA Women's Best-Ball Championship participants and must make reservations prior to the cutoff date.
