ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to amateur golfers who: a) reside within the PNGA territorial boundaries, which includes the states/provinces of Alaska, Alberta, British Columbia, Idaho, Montana, Oregon, and Washington; b) are 17 years of age or younger as of August 20, 2010; and c) have a USGA Handicap Index or RCGA Handicap Factor not exceeding 24.4 at the time of entry.

Contestants who are members of a PNGA member club will receive priority over non-PNGA member club contestants. Non-members will be put on a waiting list until the entry deadline at which time the waiting list may be used to fill the field.

ENTRIES

Entrants may apply electronically via the PNGA website, www.thepnga.org (credit card will be charged at the time of entry). Entrants may also apply on a PNGA entry form obtainable from the PNGA office or downloadable from the PNGA website. An entry fee of \$125 (U.S. Funds) shall be paid by every applicant.

Online registration or signed and completed paper entries, along with the appropriate fee, must be received by the PNGA by 4:30 p.m., on July 26, 2010. Walk-in entries will be accepted anytime, but must be received by 4:30 p.m., on July 26, 2010. Entries by telephone, e-mail, fax or incomplete entries will NOT be accepted. Entries should be mailed early to allow ample time for delay or error. The PNGA is not responsible for lost or misdirected mail. Refunds due to cancellation on or before August 9, 2010 are subject to a \$25 service fee. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED AFTER AUGUST 9, 2010.**

Late entries will be accepted and placed on an alternate's list to fill spots if they become available up until the time that the PNGA staff establishes final pairings. Late entries will not be accepted unless they are accompanied by the correct entry fee, plus an additional administrative fee of \$25. Contestants must contact the PNGA in order to submit a late entry.

CONDITIONS

The PNGA Junior Boys' Amateur Championship Committee reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The Committee reserves the right to reject the entry of any applicant, at any time, for any reason. Any decision by the Committee, in any matter, shall be final.

"SPIKELESS" SHOE POLICY

It is a condition of this competition that shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course) are prohibited during Championship play (to include practice rounds). Contestants in non-compliance with the "spikeless" policy will not be permitted to start. Players must arrive on the tee ready to play. Extra time will not be afforded for non-metal spike installation or changing of shoes. Failure to comply with the "spikeless" shoe policy will result in immediate *disqualification*.

CARTS/CADDIES

The use of automotive carts during the Championship will not be permitted. Host-club caddies may be available, contact the golf shop regarding availability. A player may furnish his own caddie. **Caddies must be 17 years of age or younger as of August 20, 2010.**

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

As a condition of this competition, the use of electronic devices, cellular phones, noise making pagers, radios, walkmans, iPods and any other similar electronic, noise making device will be prohibited during Championship play. Clarifications and special requests regarding this condition should be directed to the PNGA Rules Committee in advance.

DRESS CODE

The PNGA expects all contestants and their caddies to wear suitable attire on the host club property throughout the duration of the championship, including practice rounds. Suitable attire does not include cutoffs, short shorts, tank tops, jeans or denim of any kind or color; tee shirts, sweat pants or unkempt clothing of any kind. Contestants must wear neat and clean slacks, bermuda or walking shorts. Shorts must be no shorter than 5 inches above the middle of the knee. Golf shirts with collars or golf mocks are mandatory. Hats and visors must not be worn in the clubhouse. Shoes and socks must be worn at all times. Sandals of any kind are not allowed on the golf course at anytime (including practice areas), even sandals with soft spikes. If additional measures are required by the host club, they will be communicated to all contestants prior to the championship and must be adhered to. Gallery must adhere to the host club dress code policy. Failure to adhere to the dress code may result in disqualification and removal from the course.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Unacceptable conduct or behavior on the golf course or anywhere on club property will not be tolerated and are grounds for immediate disqualification, at any time, from any PNGA Championship. **The PNGA definition of unacceptable conduct or behavior will be provided at the Championship.**

CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE

Contestants have their choice of entering either the "Championship Division" or "Junior Division." Divisions are **not** based on age.

Championship Division: Contestants entering the Championship Division will compete from a separate set of tees at a longer yardage (6700 to 7000 yards).

Junior Division: Contestants entering the Junior Division will compete from a separate set of tees at a shorter yardage (6300 to 6500 yards).

The Championship will be conducted in two stages:

Stroke Play - All players in both divisions (including the Defending Champion) must complete the 36-hole stroke play qualifying. All flights and seeds will be determined by 36-hole qualifying scores. In the event of a tie for the Qualifying Medalist, duplicate medals will be awarded and seeding will be determined randomly. In the event of a tie for the final spot(s) in the Championship Flight, in the Championship Division only, a sudden-death playoff will be used to determine the qualifier(s). Ties (other than for the final spot(s) in the Championship Flight) will be determined randomly.

Match Play - The General Numerical Draw will be in effect. All matches are 18-holes and will be played at scratch (no handicaps). The Championship Flight will play two 18-hole matches (if you continue to win) Wednesday & Thursday, and a 36-hole Championship match on Friday. All remaining flights and Junior Division flights will play one 18-hole match each day. **Note: This is a single elimination format, there will be no drop flights.**

WITHDRAWAL POLICY

Entrants that withdraw after the entry deadline must notify the PNGA (800-643-6410) promptly in order to insure an alternate fair opportunity to play.

A "withdrawal form" is available at registration and the scoring table and must be completed by any competitor withdrawing during the course of the championship. Entrants who unofficially withdraw (by not filling out a form or without sufficient reason) will not be granted entry into any future PNGA event for a minimum of two years.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY/PRACTICE ROUND

Entrants that have met eligibility requirements will receive a confirmation of entry that will include specific practice round information and any other necessary details of the championship.

HOUSING

Private housing for contestants with host club members is very limited and based on availability. Please fill in appropriate information on the entry form. **Parents or guardians may not stay with host club members, only contestants.**

LODGING

The PNGA recommends that contestants make their lodging arrangements at the earliest possible date. The PNGA has made arrangements for reserved rooms at the following hotels.
