

X95 Wedge for the Weekend Player

KZG recently announced the release of its new X95 wedge designed specifically for the mid to high handicapper. The X95 has a single notched sole and is available in eight different loft and bounce combinations. "KZG is all about custom choices. The X95 wedges are one of the best-looking designs on the market and were engineered to be custom fit specifically for the weekend player," said KZG president Jennifer King in a press release.

"The soft sound and feel plays like a forged wedge but at a much lower price." The head, constructed from KZG's heat-treated proprietary steel alloy, gives the club a softer feel, and the single notched sole allows the player to open and close the club face without altering the bounce. Grooves are "U" shaped for a higher spin rate, but golfers looking for a KZG wedge with the new USGA conforming "V" grooves may opt for the Forged TRS wedges. \$109, kzg.com.
