What They Say: "The low center of gravity assures an ideal trajectory, and the roll and bulge guarantees perfect gear effect."

Ballflight & Distance Factors: Like many of KZG's clubheads, they're not the longest, but they might very well be the most accurate. The "U" Series produces the highest ballflight of all clubs tested, even out of the rough, where each had the right amount of resistance with the ground, keeping fat shots to a minimum.

What We Say: The company best known for its ultra-straight Gemini driver has created a simple, traditional winner in the "U" Series. Of all the clubs tested, KZG's hybrids felt most like they "were made to get the ball in the air." From the moment of address, it's easy to visualize a high, soft shot with these clubs.

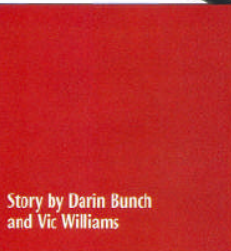
