Double Your Pleasure: It took a while for the first incarnation of this North Hollywood, Calif., custom golf company's Gemini driver to pass muster with the USGA, but we loved it all along, legal or not. Maybe now that the Gemini comes with a 460cc head, it'll turn *more* heads on and off the tours.

Setup Sense: At address, the Gemini II presents as a pure player's club — very little offset, a classic teardrop line from the toe to the well-loaded trailing edge and no bulkiness found on some big drivers.

Sweet Thunder: You can feel the rebound off the club's thinner inner face, and then watch out — there seems to be less backspin, meaning that long par 4 just got shorter. Even a toed hit yielded a 280-yard shot in our tests. At sea level, no less.

Final Verdict: The Gemini is offered in three launch angles — low (LL), mid (ML) and super (SL), which means you can forget the overblown number, rear back, keep in balance and let those two faces do their miracle work. Wanna kill it? Go with KZG.
