### KZG GEMINI £250

For me, this has the best looking head of the bunch with its traditional pear-shaped profile, like a 460cc Titleist in black. It's easy to hit, too; the double-faced technology seems to work. It didn't go as far as some, but this is meant to be custom-fitted so distance would probably increase with the right shaft.

### BANG BANG-O-MATIC £250

### BEN HOGAN BIG BEN C-S3 £249

With its unusual shape, the Hogan is slightly smaller than most of the drivers tested but has the same sized face, making it appear slightly stunted front to back. This driver is loud and long, and the draw model made a real difference for the slicers in the group. The Aldila NV-H shaft hits higher than the standard NV.
