

Having Fun at Farm Day

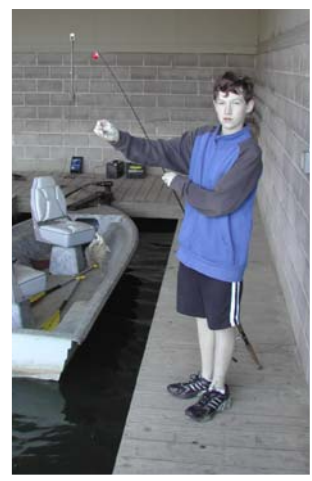
