Golf Outing Information

About the Course

Designed by Edmund Ault in 1963, this 6,713 yard, par-72 layout is characterized by slightly rolling hills indicative to the area. The course offers undulating bentgrass greens, several long doglegs and water hazards that come into play making it a challenge for players of all levels.

Previously a host for Kemper Open qualifying and a local qualifying site for the 1994 U.S. Open, Montgomery Country Club is widely recognized for its superb layout and conditioning. Over the past two years, our championship course hosted the Maryland State Golf Association (MSGA) Senior Women's Amateur, Middle Atlantic PGA Match Play qualifier and the 2011 MSGA Senior Open. The course is scheduled to host the 2012 MAGA Mid-Amateur.

The installation of a new irrigation system and new greens, along with extensive bunker renovations, has enhanced the natural aesthetics and playability of this gem, making it the place to play in the metropolitan area.

Rates and Starting Times

Golf outing rates vary depending on the package you choose: Par Package (\$89/\$79 per person), Birdie Package (\$109/\$99) and Eagle Package (\$129/\$119). We ask that shotgun starts tee off at 9 a.m. or 1 p.m. Those teeing off in the morning will receive the lower pricing listed above.

Terms & Conditions

Deposits

A deposit of \$500 is required when the outing agreement is executed. The deposit is non-refundable.

Guarantee

Seven (7) days prior to the outing, the outing coordinator must provide a final count of the guaranteed number of players to the Head Professional, as well as the final food and beverage requirements to the Food & Beverage Manager. The group will be financially responsible for the guaranteed number of participants, or the actual number of participants, whichever is greater. The group will also be responsible for the entire food and beverage guarantee, plus any additional consumption on the day of the outing. If no notice is given, the number of players listed on the contract becomes the guarantee.

Weather

Frost, fog or inclement weather may cause a delay of starting times. Montgomery Country Club reserves the right to postpone the outing due to inclement weather. Decisions are at the sole discretion of the Club and will be based on the risk to golfers and playability of the golf course. Whenever the golf course is determined playable, all outing fees will be assessed based on the guaranteed number of participants. In the event of a "rain-out" *before* the outing, the outing will be rescheduled for a mutually agreed upon date. If the outing cannot be rescheduled, the \$500 deposit will be fully refunded. If course officials determine that a "rain-out" has occurred *during* the event, an equitable adjustment will be made by Club management.

Final Payment

Payment is to be in the form of credit card, cash, check made out to Montgomery Country Club or member charge. Full payment of all outing fees must be paid before the Club closes on the day of the event. Other payment terms must be approved by Club management in advance of the event. A past due invoice is subject to late fees.

Golf Course & Golf Cart Usage

Special events do not eliminate other play. One hundred forty-four (144) players constitute a full field and the club reserves the right to fill available space. All players must use golf carts. If an event requires more than seventy-four (74) carts, the cart fees in excess of seventy-four (74) will be at a cost of \$40 per cart.

Outside Food, Alcohol & Prizes

Sponsoring organizations or individuals may not bring food, beverages, golf equipment or apparel to be either consumed, distributed, sold or auctioned on the premises unless otherwise noted in the outing agreement. **All** alcoholic beverages must be purchased through the Club. **No** outside alcoholic beverages are to be brought on the premises.

Liability

The event group and chairperson are responsible for all participants and guests, including their conduct, attire, use and care of the golf course and all other facilities and equipment, including golf carts. Further, the event group and chairperson agrees to be held liable for any damage to persons, the golf course, equipment, golf carts, or facilities caused by the event, its participants or any third parties, and that any damages to the above will result in the event group and chairperson being billed for said damages.

The event group or chairperson agrees to protect, indemnify, and hold harmless Montgomery Country Club and all affiliated companies and individuals associated with the Club from and against all expenses, damages, claims, suits, action, judgments, and costs whatsoever, including attorney fees arising out of, or in any way connected with any claim to personal injury or death resulting from the services the entity shall render. This indemnity shall survive any termination of the agreement.



Code of Conduct & Reminders

Golf Course Care

Please obey cart rules, replace divots, repair ball marks and rake sand bunkers.

Dress Code

Proper attire is required at all times. This means men shall wear golf shirts with collars and non-denim pants or shorts. Women shall wear proper golf attire; no short shorts, halters or bare midriffs are permitted. Tee shirts, denim and cut-offs are not proper attire for the golf course.

Golf Carts

All players must use golf carts. Carts must be operated in a safe manner by persons at least 18 years old.

Pace of Play

The expected playing time is 4.5 hours or less. Each group is expected to keep pace with the group ahead and play ready golf.

Alcohol Policy

All alcoholic beverages must be purchased through the Club. **No** outside alcoholic beverages are to be brought on the premises.

Things to Remember

Seven (7) days prior to the outing, the outing coordinator must provide a final count of the guaranteed number of golfers, as well as the final food and beverage requirements.

In addition, please provide the staff a preliminary list of participants, the pairing, contests and rental club requirements seven (7) days in advance.

Lastly, please remember full payment of all outing fees must be paid before the Club closes on the day of the event. Other payment terms must be approved by the General Manager in advance of the event. A past due invoice is subject to late fees.
