SUMMER PROGRAMS

Both Full and Half Day camps are offered. Full day camps also offer the option of boarding. One instructor per six campers will insure everyone gets the individual instruction needed to become a better golfer. All campers will receive a golf shirt, hat, golf balls, junior instruction booklet and end of camp favor. Parents are encouraged to attend the awards presentation at the conclusion of the last day of camp.

COMMUTING: Check in will take place from 8:45 a.m.—9:00 a.m., pick up at 4:00 p.m. Lunch and snacks will be provided.

BOARDING: Check in will take place on the Sunday prior to the first day of camp from 5:30 p.m.—6:00 p.m., pick up at 4:00 p.m. on the last day of camp.
