CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

FORMAT

The Player's Tour Series is an individual stroke play competition organized and run by the Puerto Rico Golf Association. Play is governed by the 2012/ 2013 USGA Rules of Golf, the PRGA Hard Card (available at the Starting tees) and the Conditions of Competition.

TEEING GROUND

Professionals - Blue Tees
Regular Amateur Championship - Blue Tees
Mid-Amateur Championship - Blue Tees
Senior - White Tees
Super-Seniors - White Tees
All 1st Flight Divisions - White Tees
Ladies - Red Tees

USE of CADDIES

Caddies are allowed. A caddie may ride on a golf cart, but must remain on the path. Player must pay for cart used by caddie.

SPECTATORS

Are required to walk at **ALL TIMES** and should stay in the rough or on the cart paths.

SCORECARD

At the completion of the round, each player is responsible for returning his official scorecard signed and attested by his marker, to the PRGA Official assigned to the Scoring Table, as soon as possible.

TIME OF STARTING

If a player arrives at the tee assigned, ready to play, within **FIVE MINUTES** after his starting time, in the absence of circumstances which would warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole played instead of disqualification. (Note of Rule 6-3a is in effect)

COMPLETION OF TOURNAMENT

The competition is officially closed when all scores have been posted on the scoreboard. In the event of bad weather or because of unforeseen circumstances the competition needs to be shortened, results will be deemed official at the conclusion of 9 holes.

PRACTICE

Practice on or near the putting green of the hole last played is **PROHIBITED**.

IMMOVABLE OSTRUCTIONS

Artificially surfaced cart path are obstructions. White lined areas tying into roads and paths have the same status as the roads or paths, and thus they are obstructions and not ground under repair. Exit and entrance to paved cart paths are part of the obstruction. Any railing or stakes supporting ropes on the course for the purpose of directing cart traffic adjacent to a cart path are deemed to be part of the obstruction constituted by the cart path. Distance markers on the fairway are immovable obstruction.

TIES

In case of a tie for first place in any division, there will be **NO** playoff immediately following regulation play. Tied participants will share points in the PRGA Ranking System.

WATER HAZARDS

-Black tarp/liner and cement on water hazards is considered integral part of the course.
-Unmarked Water Hazards are defined by the edge of the water.

TRANSPORTATION

Upon availability on volunteers, shuttles will be provided from hole #14 to hole #15 and from hole #16 to hole #17.
